



**TEACHER TRAINING IN THE LIFELONG
LEARNING SECTOR:
Meeting the challenge of change**

National Bodies such as LLUK and Ofsted are focusing ever more attention to enhancing the quality of Initial Teacher Training programmes. Those responsible for ITT programmes are aware of the need to assimilate and embed these changes while remaining focused on the day to day challenge of ensuring the highest quality.

Ofsted, for example, are proposing changes to the inspection methodology for initial teacher training from September 2008. The changes are likely to involve more demanding expectations from Ofsted. Teacher training programmes will be expected to set the standard for the rest of the college, responding successfully to the new inspection demands. This underlines the fact that those who teach teachers must daily perform at the highest level, leading change and modelling best practice.

This one day national conference examines current and planned changes and practical ways to respond to them. Sessions include:
