Teaching strategies that have proven impact on learning and achievement

The Teaching and Learning team at the SSAT have engaged leading researchers and teachers in a project that trains teachers in advanced teaching strategies. There is wide acceptance amongst researchers about two findings:

1. What teachers do in classrooms has three to four times the effect on student achievement than any other factor, including leadership.
2. Some teaching strategies are far more effective than others.

Remember: 20% of what you do makes 80% of the difference (Petty, 2009), so there can hardly be a better way to improve achievement than to get teachers using the teaching methods that work best. We are offering a limited number of schools the opportunity to attend our one-day training events in January and learn more about these strategies, and their subsequent embedding throughout school.

Advanced teaching and learning training days in January
